**1. INTRODUCTION**

Seplat Energy Producing Nigeria Unlimited (SEPNU) operator of the NNPC/SEPNU Joint Venture (JV) plans to carry out of Fluids Engineering Services on its offshore exploration, appraisal, and production location(s) in NNPC/SEPNU JV acreages. Anticipated contract term is five (5) years with a two (2) year optional extension period.

**2. SCOPE OF WORK**

The scope of work shall involve the provision of personnel, services, equipment, and consumables associated with Fluid Engineering (Drilling & Completion Fluids) Services that comply with company and industry standards and specifications to be utilized on a periodic callout basis. Contractor shall ensure Drilling & Completion Fluids design, materials and equipment integrity and operability. Contractor shall perform a survey of Company's drilling unit(s), consult with drilling unit management and develop Drilling & Completion fluid equipment installation plan(s) to ensure Contractor's system meets specifications and comply with all Nigeria government, drilling unit classification society, drilling unit management and Company requirements regarding location, zero-discharge, noise, emissions, etc.

All Bidders must demonstrate ownership of in-country blending and bulking facility in Onne.

**3. MANDATORY REQUIREMENT**

All successfully pre-qualified suppliers in this category will receive Invitation to Technical Tender (ITT).

**4. NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS**

Company is committed to the development of the Nigerian Oil and Gas business in compliance with the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development Act 2010 (NOGICD Act) enacted by the Federal Government of Nigeria in April 2010.

As from the commencement of this Act, the minimum Nigerian Content in any project, service or product specification to be executed in the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry shall be consistent with the level set in the Schedule to the Act and any other targets as may be directed by the Nigerian Content Development and Monitoring Board (NCDMB).

NNPC/SEPNU requires their Contractors to comply with the Act, its attached Schedule and any applicable regulation developed by the NCDMB.

Nigerian Content (NC) in the Nigerian oil and gas industry is defined as:

"The quantum of composite value added to or created in the Nigerian economy by a systematic development of capacity and capabilities through the deliberate utilization of Nigerian human, material resources and services in the Nigerian oil and gas industry."

"Nigerian company" is a company formed and registered in Nigeria in accordance with the provisions of Companies and Allied Matters Act with not less than 51% equity shares by Nigerians.

Tenderers shall consider Nigerian content as an important element of their overall project development and management philosophy for project execution.

**As part of their submissions, Tenderers shall:**

- (a) Demonstrate that the entity is a Nigerian registered company with greater than 51% equity shareholding. Also, provide form CO2 and CO7, evidence of registration with NCDMB NOGIC JQS and NUPRC certificate.
- (b) Demonstrate detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (address, layout drawing, lease document of technical & administrative office.) in Nigeria to support this contract
- (c) 1) Provide evidence of either of the under-listed valid Category 1,2,3,4 or 5 NCEC and/or provided MOA with vendor having either of the under-listed NCEC demonstrating ownership of blending & Bulking facility in Onne/drilling fluids equipment to be utilized in the execution of the work scope.
  - i. Manufacturing and Related Services (MS) NCEC
  - ii. Services and Support (SS) NCEC2) Provide Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with in-country Barite and Drilling Fluid Processor in line with NCDMB published guideline for the utilization of locally produced Barite and Bentonite in Nigerian oil and gas Industry
- (d) Provide a project-specific organogram showing the Names and Nationalities of all key personnel not limited to (Desk Drilling and Completion Fluids Engineer, Senior Mud Engineer, Junior Mud Engineer, Helper/Assistant) that will execute the work scope for this service. CVs of all personnel listed in the project organogram should be submitted. For any position to be occupied by Expatriate personnel, tenderer shall commit to obtaining expatriate quota approval from NCDMB before project execution.
- (e) Comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guidelines by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development, and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).
